



**UZH Global Strategy and Partnership Funding Scheme
Quality and Impact Monitoring**

In order to ensure the benefits and effectiveness of the new funding model for strategic networking at UZH, a quality and impact monitoring is carried out by the Global Affairs department at regular intervals. This will be reported to the Executive Board of the University.

The following table shows the time periods and the monitoring criteria for each stage of the funding model:
